Report from Brother Rao

Here is a recent report from Brother Rao who has worked for many years in the Andra Pradesh Region of India. He set up the FACT (Faith Action for Community Transformation www.fact-india.org) project that is reaching out to many people at grass roots level in this region.

In the last ten years their activities have broadened in the fields of female literacy, formal education for children, non-formal education, rural employment, income generating skills, self help group formation, community health and awareness programmes on various social issues. These activities reach out to poor and marginalised women, adolescents and disadvantaged and marginalised children from rural and urban areas of Krishna district.

FACT's journey owes much to the unstinting support of a large number of friends, supporters and well-wishers, who have a burden to help the poor and needy.

Brother Rao was able to share on this work at the Ministries Without Borders World Watch conference in Cardiff, UK in 2009.

“Our God is so good and He has blessed me and our ministry in 2009. We faced several problems last year, but saw the helping hand of the Lord in each and every movement. Many of the families we work with are very strong Hindu devotees and have been in the clutches of idols for many years. But God has touched their hearts and they have

surrendered their lives to Him. In one month, 192 men and women accepted the Lord. Amen!

One man from a village called Vullupalem miraculously accepted the Lord as his personal saviour. He was notorious for causing us trouble, but one day he was bitten by a cobra and fell unconscious. We prayed for him from 10am to 4pm. Hallelujah, glory to God, at 4.15pm the man was healed! He was surprised and started crying, saying “now I know how God loves me and has saved my life.” God has been doing many miracles; healing the sick, releasing people from evil and changing many lives.

We have also been doing social work, supporting the women to overcome poverty by starting their own agricultural business. We are praying and fasting for 70 milk cows lost during the recent floods; each costing 20,000 rupees.

This year a total of 267 members were added to the Kingdom. Our target is to reach more than 500 families this year. I have a burden for the over 8 million Hindus in the Andhra Pradesh region. Please remember our ministry in your prayers. May God give you more blessings in 2010. Happy New Year. Your Brother, Rao”

Lets continue to pray for the work going on round the world extending the kingdom of God in every area.
