Kids' Club is an hour of fun, games, music and Bible teaching for 7-11 year olds every other Saturday morning. Kids' Club exists for those children who live in the areas surrounding King's House but also as a place the children from the church can come and bring their friends to learn more about how wonderful Jesus is.

The children enjoyed popping balloons, swapping smelly socks, singing songs and hearing stories about Jesus and learning the memory verse "*keep your eyes fixed on Jesus*" (Hebrews 12:2, NIV). Hearing them sing about the reign of God and talk about what it means to fix their eyes on Jesus was amazing!
